GENERAL INFORMATION

On July 14, 2014, the United States Department of State, Office of Children's Issues put into effect the requirement that all intercountry adoptions required a US Hague Accredited agency as Primary Provider. This meant that families could no longer complete an inter-country adoption without a Primary Provider Agency. Nightlight Christian Adoptions works with families who are interested in adopting relatives or completing an intercountry adoption through the UAA process. As the countries are varied and across the globe, the adoption process varies according to the country. Many of the countries provide for a 'guardianship' process with the actual adoption taking place and being finalized in the US. Each situation is evaluated on a case by case basis to determine whether Nightlight can assist the family with their adoption. Some of the countries are signatories of The Hague and others are non-Hague countries. It is expected that the adoption process may take anywhere between 2-3 years, depending on the laws of both countries. Morocco does not have a central adoption authority and all cases are process through local courts.

CHILDREN AVAILABLE

• Children from the age of about three months are eligible for Kafala and subsequent adoption from Morocco and referred to families through the local courts. Most Moroccan children eligible for intercountry adoption are relatively healthy or have mild/correctable medical diagnoses. The country refers almost exclusively boys and is not a good option for families only open to adopting a girl. Sibling groups are very uncommon in this program.

ELIGIBILITY TO ADOPT

- Applicants must be actively practicing Sunni Muslims, preferably lifelong but for at least 5 years.
- Applicants must be at least 25 years of age.
- Applicants must be at least 18 years older than the prospective adoptive child.
- Applicants 45 years old or more at the time of dossier submission must be open to adopting a child to 36 months of age at the time of referral.
- Married couples and single women may adopt.
- Applicants must meet US income standards of 125% over poverty and be in good physical and mental health.

PROCESS

- 1. For a proposed kinship adoption of a relative child, collect all required child documents and provide to Nightlight coordinator (proof of orphan status; parent death certificates or relinquishment of rights; medical evaluation; school and social report
- 2. For all adoptions, complete our online application
- 3. Complete our International Adoption Services Contract & pay the Monitoring and Oversight fee. The Monitoring and Oversight fee is paid to IAAME, the accrediting entity designated by the US Department of State/Office of Children's Issues, the US Central Authority.)
- 4. Orientation meeting with Nightlight Staff, reviewing the intercountry adoption process from Morocco. Review and return Service Plan.
- 5. Begin your Home Study with Nightlight or an approved Hague Accredited agency that is identified and approved by Nightlight.
- 6. Once your Home Study has been completed, Nightlight will review the Home Study and assist you with preparing your I-600A (Application for Advance Processing of an Orphan Petition): https://www.uscis.gov/sites/default/files/document/forms/i-600a.pdf.
- 7. Morocco Dossier: Nightlight will assist you in putting together the packet of documents required by the local courts and the US embassy.
- 8. Receive approval of the I-600A.
- 9. Submit your complete dossier for review by Nightlight, followed by shipment to Morocco, and approval and registration with the local court.
- 10. Referral wait of varying length, depending on the specifics of the child request outlined in the home study.
- 11. Upon receipt of a referral, Nightlight Clinical staff will review the specific child referral medical, social, psychological reports with the family.

- 12. If the referral is accepted, the family travels to Morocco for 6 to 12 weeks to finalize the process, including the Islamic investigation, court Kafala process, I-600 filing and US visa process.
- 13. Complete a minimum of 5 post placement reports once you return home and finalize the adoption via the court in your state of residence.

TRAVEL & ADOPTION

The Morocco program requires a single trip of 6 to 12 weeks, depending on the child's location and the local process. The trip begins with meeting the child as well as the interviews with social workers, the police and the Islamic Affairs office. If all requirements are satisfied, the case moves through the court Kafala process and the child's guardianship documents are issued. After obtaining the child's passport, the family moves into the I-600 and US visa process and can return home once a visa has been granted.

POST PLACEMENT/ADOPTION

Your child will arrive home under a Kafala (guardianship) from a local Moroccan court. This means that you must finalize your adoption in your state of residence by petitioning the court. Following finalization, you can obtain the child's Certificate of US citizenship and US passport. Post-placement/adoption reports are required at 3 months, 6 months, 12 months, 18 months and 24 months from Kafala. In accordance with state law, at least the first two reports must be generated by a social worker. Once the adoption has been finalized, reports can be family generated, if permissible by state law. Reports must be sent to Nightlight and on to the proper authorities in Morocco.

COSTS

The program fee for an adoption from Morocco is \$28,500. Your additional costs will include home study, post placement, post adoption shipping reports to Morocco, immigration fees, country attorney, travel, documents or communication. Your out-of-pocket expenses may further be reduced if you receive scholarships, grants or employer-provided adoption benefits. Please see the fee schedule.

2. Complete your Orientation

Once we review and accept your Application materials, we will send you an acceptance letter via email. Shortly after that you will receive an invoice for the orientation phase and then begin your orientation with your adoption advisor.

3. Obtain a Home Study

- If you live in Nightlight's licensed area, we will perform your home study. Once your application is approved, your adoption advisor will notify you how to get started on your home study with one of our Nightlight offices.
- If you are out of Nightlight's licensed area, we will help you find a local agency.

The cost of operating an international adoption program is substantial and increasing with the additional compliance requirements under the Hague Convention on Intercountry Adoption. The nature of international adoption makes it impossible to predict the exact costs you will incur, but we believe the estimates above are realistic. Although we strive to maintain a predictable fee schedule, unexpected increase in our costs may necessitate an increase in fees. Therefore, fees may be increased upon 90 day notice. Program fees are paid in phases and are non-refundable. Nightlight establishes a budget for costs each year based on the number of adoptions it estimates completing, as well as revenue from grants and donations. Based on these estimates, we establish program fees to cover the costs of attorneys, facilitators, social workers, insurance, and other costs we incur. Of course it would be prohibitive to allocate all of the costs (payroll, rent, insurance, supplies, travel, etc) to one adoption in one program.

A late fee of 12% annual (1% monthly) will be assessed for fees more than 30 days past due.
