## WE SUPPORT WOMEN IN CRISIS PREGNANCY

Nightlight Christian Adoptions is an extension of your pro-life ministry. We offer free, unbiased counseling for women in crisis pregnancy. Consider making a monthly or annual commitment from your missions or evangelism budget to support our birth mother fund. If you have women facing unplanned pregnancy, or families considering foster care or adoption, send them our way!

## WE SOLVE THE GUILT OVER FROZEN EMBRYOS

About 1 out of 10 families in your church have embryos in frozen storage. Give them the option of LIFE for their remaining embryos. Nightlight will help them choose an adopting family who will then give birth to their adopted children. Adoption just 9 months earlier!

You may have foster or adoptive parents who need a weekend of respite. Nightlight can help provide respite care or supervise this ministry. Perhaps some of your families would like to volunteer to help give families a weekend of rest.
